### Pantomime:

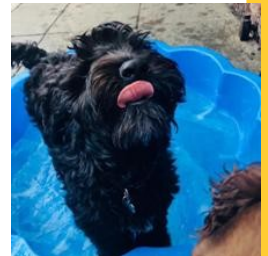
