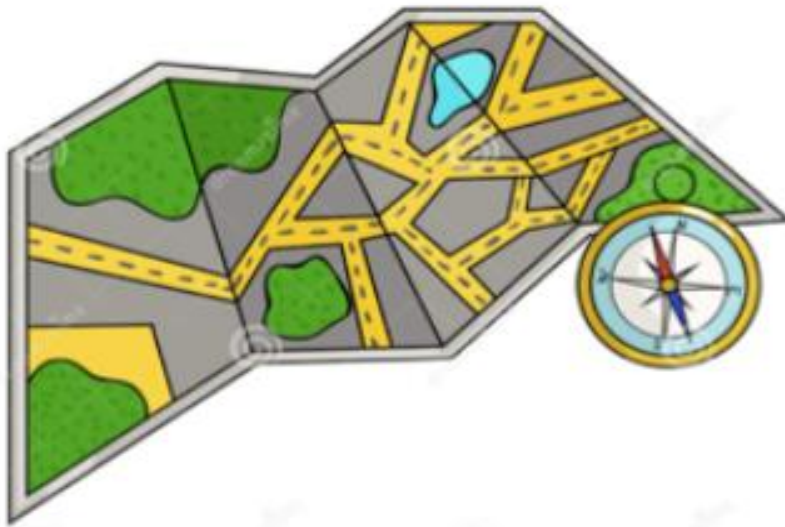


## Map & Atlas Skills

### Intent:

- ✓ All the time in the World. (Greenwich Meridian/Prime Meridian & time zones)
- ✓ Naughty Elephants Squirt Water! (Compass Points)
- ✓ Locating places using 4 and 6 figure grid references.
- ✓ Sketch maps, keys and symbols.
