In EYFS, music is taught through Expressive Arts and Design and Communication and Language. In Nursery, the children sing ‘Rhyme of the week’ and learn to use instruments, actions and movement to accompany the rhyme as they recognise the beat. A variety of songs are taught and learnt to support the children’s daily routines and rules within the setting. Music is also encouraged outdoors where the children have access to a range of musical instruments and streamers to develop the children’s musical skills. The children are provided with junk modelling materials to make their own instruments e.g. making a shaker using an old plastic bottle. The children also learn how to change familiar songs in order to make it their own.
